



Sermon Series - Romans 8

**A LIFE OF SECURITY (Romans 8:31-39)**

Five unanswerable questions lead to five unshakable assurances:

**Question 1:** If God is for us, who can be against us?

**Response: GOD IS** \_\_\_\_\_.

- We can conquer our fear of \_\_\_\_\_!

“For I know the plans that I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.’” Jeremiah 29:11 (NASB)

**Question 2:** He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all—how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

**Response: GOD WILL** \_\_\_\_\_.

The Greek word for **He gave him up** is *paradidomi*, the same word used for Judas betraying Jesus in Mark 14:10.

**Question 3:** Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen?

**Response: GOD WILL** \_\_\_\_\_.

**Question 4:** Who is the one who condemns?

**Response: GOD WILL NOT** \_\_\_\_\_.

“*He condemned sin in sinful man...*” Romans 8:3 (NIV)

“*Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.*” (Romans 8:34)

Four ways I know this to be true:

1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for me.
2. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for me.
3. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ at God’s right hand for me.
4. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for me.

**Question 5:** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?

**Response: GOD WILL NOT** \_\_\_\_\_.

“*Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*” Romans 8:35-39 (NIV)

The tense of Paul’s words indicates: “I have \_\_\_\_\_ convinced and I will \_\_\_\_\_ convinced.”
